During a Sensory Friendly Skate, there will be no music played, no unnecessary loud sounds, as well as a reduced capacity on the number of individuals allowed on the ice. This skate is open to all participants however, all skaters require 1:1 support and/or family on the ice. As part of this pi

lot initiative, four Sensory Friendly Skates will be offered during the 2025–2026 skating season to assess the feasibility of implementing the program on a permanent basis.
