Anvil is a Canadian heavy metal band formed in Toronto, Ontario, in 1978. The band currently consists of foun ding members Steve "Lips" Kudlow (vocals, guitar), Robb Reiner (drums, percussion), and Chris Robertson (b ass). The band has released nineteen studio albums, and have been cited as having influenced many notable heavy metal groups, including Megadeth, Slayer, Anthrax, and Metallica.

Anvil's antics on and off stage, the setbacks they suffered, and their determination to keep going have been compared to the fictional band Spinal Tap.

In 2008, the band was the subject of the documentary film Anvil! The Story of Anvil, directed by the screenwrit er and former Anvil roadie Sacha Gervasi. The film garnered critical acclaim from many major publications; Ro lling Stone called it "the year's most praised rock doc. At the film's premiere, which took place at the 2008 Sund ance Film Festival, the band played "Cat Scratch Fever" with Slash and Anthrax's Scott Ian.

The high praise for the movie put Anvil back into the public consciousness,[and brought the band opening slots with AC/DC and Saxon, plus appearances at major festivals, including the Download,Hellfest, Bumbershoot and SXSW.

The venerable Canadian hard rock troupe Fist was founded in 1979 by guitarist/vocalist Ron Chenier, and thro ughout the course of the next few decades was a popular touring act in Canada and abroad.

BIOGRAPHY

During a career that has spanned more than 25 years, Susan Aglukark's journey as a singer-songwriter has led h er to reflect on who she is, where she comes from and the importance of discovery – discovery of history, cultu re and self.

Susan is the first Inuk artist to win a Juno (3) and a Governor General's Performing Arts Award for lifetime artistic achievement, she is an officer of the Order of Canada, holds several Honourary Doctorate degrees and has held command performances; but Susan also acknowledges the path has not been easy.

"Here I was, living a life I never imagined, but I was struggling to understand who I was. There was no opportunity growing up to learn about who we were, the Inuit, from our own perspective. In essence, we were institutionalized by being told who we were, how we would live and when you are told a story for so long, you learn to be elieve it," explains Susan.

During the past 25 years of reflection and songwriting, Susan kept coming back to one area of profound knowing, the Inuit are an extraordinary people deeply grounded in a culture forged by their Ancestors, their journey is what shaped them.

"Their life experience is the foundation on which our precepts of determination, adaptability and love for life ar e built, they began the journey to our present-day Nunavut." (Susan's Walrus Talks comments)

"The conversations around reconciliation have provided an opportunity to begin to re-write our narrative. The I ndigenous people in Canada come from highly organized societies built on knowledge, process and organizatio n – without which none of us would have survived."

For Susan, art has played a significant role in her healing journey and in the re-writing of her narrative, she belie ves it plays an important role for indigenous youth who are dealing with contemporary identity issues today. "O ur children and youth are strong and resilient, they still believe very strongly in their culture, in Inuit or Indigen ous culture, and they are still fighting every day to find their place."

"They need to be anchored to an identity and so much of those connections are in our ancestors and their stories and we have a duty and a responsibility to engage our children and youth in the process of connecting with and helping them write those stories."

Susan has always been very open about how her own fears and personal trauma that left her disillusioned and di sconnected. Born in Arviat, Nunavut, her parents formative years were in traditional Inuit culture, her formative years were not traditional and were somewhat disconnected from her culture.

Despite the success she experienced in the 1990s, by 1998 she was suffering from post-partum depression and f ound herself in a dark place in need of time to reflect and heal, what followed was the several years of reflectio n, healing and making deeper commitments to her singing/songwriting career. And so began what Susan calls he r "awakening". As she learned more about her culture and the strength and resilience of the Inuit who have been on this land for over 5,000 years, Susan was also engaging her own "inner artist" and falling in love with perfor ming, sharing stories and singing.

"We have an extraordinary culture and an extraordinary past, we must embrace the opportunity to learn about o ur very own heroes, write those culture bridges and reframe who we are in today's world."

Through her music, Susan continues to share her experiences as an Inuk growing up in Nunavut, as well as the

challenges faced by northern communities and Indigenous youth.

Susan is actively involved in various projects to bring food and support to northern communities and in 2016 t he Arctic Rose Foundation gained charitable status with a focus on helping youth in the north through art and o ther engaging creative projects.

Josee Bourgeois is a registered member of the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan First Nations. Although Josee gre w up in Toronto and lived the first half of her life as an urban native, she has spent the last 15 years living on 3 different reservations in Nova Scotia, Quebec, and Ontario, raising her 13-year-old son, Little Thunder Bear. Si nce 2015 Josee has become very well known in the unsurrendered territory of the Ottawa Valley as a multi disci plined, self taught dancer who has spent the last few years exploring new mediums of movement and storytellin g through dance and theatre. What began as a journey of creating presence at major Ottawa events, Josee has un expectedly turned into a part time career with the ability to create larger scale productions and visions as years p ass on. Using her ability to command center stage attention while revealing difficult truths and secrets of the int ergenerational traumas that plague her ancestry and existence thus far. Josee, is set on one day continuing her pa th of unraveling the next layer of stories needing to be told. Josee is extremely proud of the work she has create d and produced with the support of prestigious institutions and performing arts organizations, and fellow artist friends in the industry. Highlights of her career so far include, 2023 -Banff Center 2023 Indigenous Dramaturgi es exchange, 2021-2022, National Arts Center, visiting dance artist in residence, The Sickness. Ottawa Blues F est land Acknowledgment opening for The Backstreet Boys, 2019. National Art Center productions, Indigenous theatre, Mura Buai, French theatre, Gabriel Dumont- Wild West Story, English Theatre Big Bang Festival, Nomad- Mushkiki Nibi. It's important to mention that Josee's movement journey began with connecting to Pow wo w dancing, Fancy shawl, Jingle dress dancing at the age of 23. Over that past decade as she has grown as a self-d irected artist, Josee has begun a unpacking a new journey as an act of reclamation and decolonization of Indigen ous sensuality.
